The course commences outside the Drummond Hotel, St Fillans, and runs westwards to the Four Seasons Hotel it then turns right up into the forest roads and takes you through beautiful Glen Tarken and onward to lovely Glen Beich, which is deer country, to the turning point at the wee loch. You then return to the "Loop" and make your way down through the forest to the old station then down to the main A85 road and back to the hotel to the finishing point - 18 miles. **Highway Code rules must be obeyed on all roads in the village.**

The race must be completed in four hours / the race is limited to 150 Entrants
